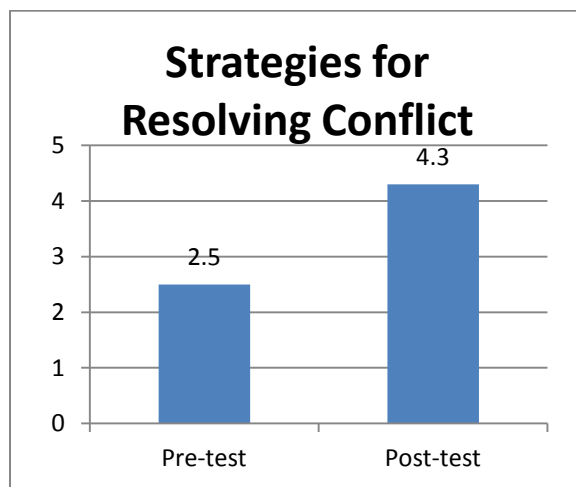
## Peace Ed: Evaluation Report Summer 2011

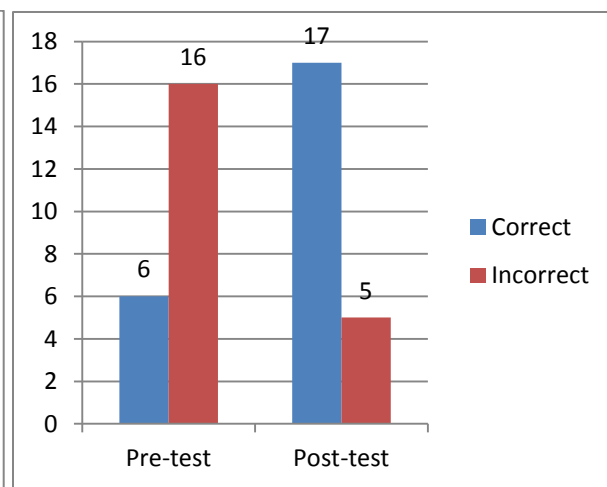

The purpose of this report is to analyze the statistical data that was collected from conflict resolution workshops that Peace Ed facilitated at Neighborhood House. In all there were twenty-two young people who participated in the workshop. Three charts that you see below look at the difference from pre-test to post-test on the participant's ability to define conflict resolution (fig. 2), name strategies for resolving conflict (Fig. 1), and their overall score on a ten item self report that looks at overall conflict resolution skill (Fig. 3). Each of these measurement areas showed a strong significant impact.
